) SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER
) REGARDING PRELIMINARY

WHEREAS, by Order dated December 23, 2013, this Court determined it would issue a Supplemental Order to reflect dates and deadlines that would work efficiently with dates and deadlines to be set by the California Superior Court's order granting preliminary approval;

WHEREAS, this Court finds that it serves the best interests of the class and all parties to have consistency between this action and the California action;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Court, having considered the dates and deadlines and minor edits to the notice plan established in the California Superior Court, the Motion for Supplemental Order on Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement, and all accompanying documents filed therewith, and the parties having consented to the entry of this order, AND GOOD CAUSE APPEARING

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Settlement information, as identified in paragraph 6(b) of this Court's December 23, 2013 Order Granting Preliminary Approval, shall remain available on the Settlement Website until **July 18, 2014**.
2. The Final Approval Hearing shall be on **May 16, 2014**.
3. Objectors' submissions must be postmarked by **April 18, 2014**.
4. All papers in support of Settlement Agreement and payment of attorneys' fees and incentive awards must be filed by **April 25, 2014**.



5. The deadline for filing claims is **July 18, 2014**. Those claims filed by mail must be postmarked by **July 18, 2014**.

6. In addition, the following changes as reflected in Exhibits B-C to the Motion for Supplemental Order are approved:

Notice Plan – Long Form


- All terminology that an item must be *mailed* or *postmarked* or *received* is now uniformly identified as “postmarked by.”

Notice Plain – Short Form

- All terminology that an item must be *mailed* or *postmarked* or *received* is now uniformly identified as “postmarked by.”
- The answer to the question “What does the Settlement Provide?” now explains that “Vermont claimants will received 8.2% of the Settlement *after fees and costs.*”
- The answer to the question “How can I get a payment” now explains that readers may find claim forms and an address for submission online at www.RoundThermostats.com or by calling 1-855-287-1280
